In addition to the EICC Global e-Sustainability Initiative, "Conflict Minerals Reporting Template", Allied Metal Company does not purchase or add any of the four (4) conflict minerals to either our aluminum or zinc alloys. Those 4 minerals (3TG) are:

- Tantalum (TA)
- Tin (SN)
- Gold (AU)
- Tungsten (W)

Our source of raw material for aluminum smelting and alloying is derived from numerous scrap metal processing operations around the United States, including silicon metal from a variety of sources; none of from the DRC (Democratic Republic of the Cong) or adjoining countries with common borders.

Likewise, zinc alloy production is completed using SHG zinc from approved LME sources, none of which are derived from the DRC or adjoining countries.
